
DIY 3D Lantern - Instructions

- 1. Print out this sheet
- 2. Cut around the dotted lines to create your lantern template ----
- 3. Trace the template onto your chosen paper for your lantern and cut out
- **4.** Use the greyed-out area on the template to sketch your lantern design
- **5.** Once you've decided on your design there are a few ways to transfer it to your lantern:
 - Cut out the shaded shape on the template from your lantern. Draw your design onto light tissue paper (the same size as the shaded shape on the template) using felt tip pens, stick this to your final lantern.
 - Cut the design straight out of the lantern to create a silhouette effect. Cover the back of your lantern with coloured tissue paper for the light to shine through.
- **6.** Once your designs are finished on your lantern, connect the two main bodies of the lantern by gluing down the side tabs, and then the top tabs



7. Glue the top (lid) of the lantern last and thread through and glue the handle

8. Cut out the Scarborough Live Advent Calendar logo and stick to your final lantern



9. Display your lantern in your window on top of your chosen light/s (not naked flame)

TOOLS NEEDED:

- Scissors
- Craft knife
- Glue Stick
- Paper to make your lantern from (black sugar paper works well at blocking out the light)
- Coloured paper to fill in the design (tissue paper works well as it lets through the light)

TOP TIPS

If using a craft knife don't forget to put a chopping board underneath so you don't damage any surfaces
